### Instructions to Validate a Technician

Gravity Training is committed to ensuring the safety of workers at height. Through quality training and assessment Gravity Training ensures that if a candidate is issued with a certificate it represents the fact that the candidate has earned it and proven that he or she can work safely in the respective field.

To ensure that this remains the case, it is of utmost importance that clients and supervisors know how to determine whether a certificate is genuine or not. A falsified certificate indicates that the holder of said certificate has not undergone the necessary training. This can lead to workers being exposed to serious risks which can lead to injury or death.

Below is an example of a Gravity Training certificate, indicated is the various aspects to verify in order to determine whether it is a genuine Gravity Training certificate or not.

The certificate features the Gravity Training logo and the text: "Certificate No.: [redacted]", "This is to certify that: [redacted]", "ID Number: [redacted]", "Has successfully completed the following course: Radio Frequency Awareness", "Date of Issue: [redacted]", "Expiry Date: [redacted]", and a QR code. 1. Unique certificate number
2. Gravity watermark
3. Technician's full names
4. Technician's ID/Passport number (this is to be used when validating a technician on Gravity's website)
5. Course name
6. Date of issue
7. Registrar signature
8. Date of expiry
9. Embossed Gravity logo
10. QR code (can be scanned to validate technician)

**Any fraudulent or suspected fraudulent certificate must be reported to Gravity. Any person found to be complacent in any fraudulent activity will be blacklisted.**
